"Cordey China was founded in Trenton, New Jersey, in 1942 by Boleslaw Cybis, a Polish painter who had come to the World's Fair in New York to paint murals for the Polish pavilion ... "

Cybis appears to have separated from Cordey sometime prior to 1957 (the year of his death) and set up on his own as Cybis Porcelain.
